- Assists faculty, staff and students
- Works to resolve issues informally
- Provides feedback and recommends changes to institution

- All identities and information discussed are held in confidence
- No formal records are kept
- Not an "Office of Notice" to the University

Exception:

Imminent risk of serious harm



Neutral

- Do not take sides
- Aim for a fair and equitable outcome for all parties
- Do not "represent" management, staff, faculty or students



Informal

- Facilitates communication
- Discusses options
- Coaching, role-playing, brainstorming
- Conducts "shuttle diplomacy" or mediation

Will not participate in formal proceedings (grievances, arbitrations, legal proceedings)



Independent

Operates independently of usual administrative structures

 Reports to Ethics and Compliance in the Chancellors office for administrative and budgetary purposes only – will not disclose identities of visitors or issues discussed



Common Issues

- Questions re: policies and procedures
- Communication issues
- Performance evaluations/discipline
- Harassment/discrimination
- Ethical considerations
- Whistleblowing
- Research data/authorship disputes



Common Student Issues

- Concerns with grading / fairness
- Discipline (academic and nonacademic)
- Issues arising from power disparities:
 - PI / Advisor concerns
 - Authorship / use of research
- Disability accommodations
- Cultural sensitivities
